A weekend of tandem riding in southwest Indiana



Located on the Wabash River, New Harmony is a historic town of just under a thousand residents in southwest Indiana. The town's [history](#) included two failed attempts to form utopian societies in the early nineteenth century. Much of the town has been preserved, and includes a roofless church, Labyrinth State Memorial, the Working Men's Institute & Library, and the New Harmony Gallery of Contemporary Art. Please visit the [New Harmony website](#) for details. Just four miles south is Harmony State Park which has cabins, camping, mountain biking, and hiking. In addition to its normal attractions, New Harmony is hosting the *Arts in Harmony Festival*; a free open air art, music, and fine craft festival on this weekend.

Weekend Schedule: All times are Central Daylight Savings Time (Chicago Time)

All rides will start at the parking lot just northeast of the New Harmony Inn office. Expect rolling terrain on all routes.

Friday, June 1

- 2:00 p.m. – [North by Northeast Ride](#): Routes of 24, 37, and 47 miles will travel north and east through the towns of Stewartsville, Poseyville, Cynthiana, and Owensville. The routes will travel many of the roads used by the Harmony Hundred ride. For those wishing an early dinner, the Red Wagon Restaurant in Poseyville awaits them.

Saturday, June 2

- 8:30 a.m. – [Mt Vernon Ride](#): Routes of 33, 47 and 69 miles will take you south toward the Ohio River. The 47 and 69 mile routes travel to Mt Vernon on the Ohio River with numerous lunch stops available in town. For those wishing additional miles, feel free to add a ten mile loop through Harmony State Park (admission of \$2 per person).
- 9:00a.m. – 5:00p.m. Arts in Harmony Festival (free)
- 5:00 p.m.. –Cash Bar in the Tillich Room at the Red Geranium Restaurant
- 6:00 p.m. – Dinner in the Tillich Room at the Red Geranium Restaurant

Sunday, June 3

- 8:30 a.m. – [Darmstadt Ride](#): Routes of 26, 38, 45, 54, and 61 miles will head east through Wadesville, with the longer route going to Darmstadt.
- 10:00a.m. – 4:00p.m. Arts in Harmony Festival (free)

Overnight Accommodations:

We have a block of rooms at the [New Harmony Inn Resort](#) that will be held until May 1. The nightly rate for a standard or deluxe room is \$109 plus tax. Please call the hotel at 1-812-682-4431 and mention "HOOTS" when making your reservation. You may keep your bike in the hotel room, but please be sure to keep it reasonably clean before you bring it into the hotel. You're responsible if grease or dirt from your bike requires cleanup by the hotel staff. There are several B&Bs in town, as well as Guest Houses for rent. Camping – There is camping in New Harmony at [Murphy Park](#), and [Harmony State Park](#) (4 miles south of New Harmony) has cabins and camping.

Ride Information

All rides will start at the parking lot just northeast of the New Harmony Inn office. All participants must sign a Central Indiana Bicycling Association (CIBA) waiver at the beginning of the event. You will be provided with a map and cue sheet at the start of all rides, but you may download them in advance at www.tandemhoots.org. Routes will NOT be marked with Dan Henrys. There will be no formal SAG support. Although our cell phone number will be provided on the cue sheet, we will be riding the event, and will not be able to respond immediately. Routes are designed to allow rest stops at convenience stores and restaurants along the route. There are no bicycle stores in New Harmony; we recommend that you bring extra tubes and supplies.

Saturday Banquet

Included in your entry fee is a buffet dinner in the Tillich Room of the Red Geranium Restaurant. The buffet will include Bruschetta grilled chicken, vegetarian lasagna, steamed broccoli, wild rice pilaf, salad, dinner rolls, dessert, water, and ice tea. The chef will create a special dinner for vegans, and you should let us know if you are vegan or have other special dietary needs. A cash bar will be available.
